Players' Code of Conduct

1. Respect & Behaviour

Players must at all times:

- Show respect to teammates, opponents, match officials, coaches, club officials, volunteers, and spectators
- Accept decisions of referees and match officials without dissent
- Avoid aggressive, abusive, discriminatory, or offensive language or behaviour
- Uphold the principles of fair play and sportsmanship
- Act in a manner that reflects positively on Drumoghill FC on and off the pitch

Bullying, harassment, intimidation, or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.

2. Compliance with FAI Rules & Club Policies

Players must comply with all FAI rules and regulations, the FAI Respect Programme, and Drumoghill FC club rules, safeguarding policies, and disciplinary procedures.

3. Safeguarding & Welfare

Players must treat all young players with care, dignity, and respect. Any safeguarding concern must be reported to the Club Children's Officer or a club official.

4. Training, Matches & Commitment

Players are expected to attend training and matches punctually, notify management of absences, follow coaching instructions respectfully, and give their best effort at all times.

5. Discipline & Match Day Conduct

Players must avoid violent or dangerous play, accept team selections and substitutions respectfully, and refrain from alcohol, drugs, or betting on football in line with FAI regulations.

6. Social Media & Public Conduct

Players must use social media responsibly and avoid posting content that could damage the reputation of Drumoghill FC or the FAI.

7. Sanctions

Breaches of this Code may result in disciplinary action, including warnings, suspensions, fines, or termination of membership.

8. Acknowledgement

Adherence to this Code of Conduct is a condition of registration with Drumoghill FC.
