1. Policy Statement

Drumoghill Football Club is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all players, coaches, volunteers, officials, parents, spectators and visitors involved in club activities.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all club activities including training, matches, travel, events, facilities and equipment.

3. Responsibilities

The club committee, coaches, volunteers and members all share responsibility for maintaining a safe environment.

4. Risk Assessment

Risk assessments will be completed for all club activities and reviewed annually or following any incident.

5. First Aid & Medical Provision

Appropriate first aid provision will be available at all training sessions and matches.

6. Accident & Incident Reporting

All accidents, injuries and near misses must be recorded and reported to the club committee.

7. Emergency Procedures

Procedures are in place for serious injury, fire, evacuation and severe weather conditions.

8. Equipment & Facilities Safety

All playing equipment and facilities will be checked before use and maintained in a safe condition.

9. Child Welfare & Safeguarding

This policy operates alongside the club's Child Safeguarding Statement and safeguarding procedures.

10. Communication & Training

This policy will be communicated to all members, coaches and volunteers.

11. Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually by the club committee.
